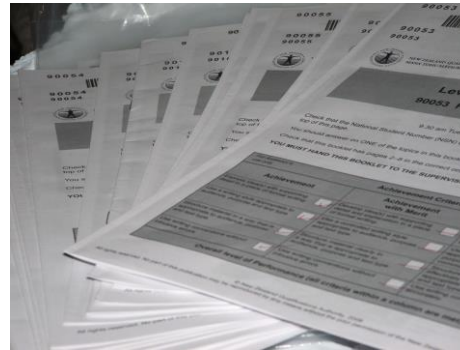

NEW SEMESTER GRADE CALCULATION

“50-POINT PERCENTAGE MODEL”

- Semester grade is calculated mathematically
- Q1 = 40%
- Q2 = 40%
- Exam = 20%
- $0.4(Q1) + 0.4(Q2) + 0.2(\text{Exam}) = \text{Semester Grade}$

EXAMPLE 1

(40%) Q1 89

(40%) Q2 93

(20%) E1 88

(100%) S1 90.4 A

EXAMPLE 2

(40%) Q1 78

(40%) Q2 75

(20%) E1 60

(100%) S1 73.2 C

“50-POINT PERCENTAGE MODEL”

- **Lowest Q or Exam Grade = 50%**

- ✦ Peer districts
- ✦ Previous practice
- ✦ Equitable
- ✦ Research based

(40%) Q1 25

(40%) Q2 65

(20%) E1 70

(100%) S1 50 F

EXAMPLE 3

(40%) Q1 ~~25~~ → 50

(40%) Q2 65

(20%) E1 70

(100%) S1 ~~50 F~~ → 60 D

SEMESTER GRADE FORMULA

- $0.4(Q1) + 0.4(Q2) + 0.2(\text{Exam}) = \text{Semester Grade}$
