#### • Approval of December Minutes

- Clarify that the Superintendent recommended to the school board to change school start time
- Motion to approve R. Graeter, second S. Nelson; all approve

#### • Old business

- Mental wellness update
  - Meeting with Nancy Miller, 1N5 and BC2M Leaders to discuss how to utilize grant money from the Warrior Run, \$2517.00
  - Discussed possible Ted Talk type presentation by college age students focusing on specific issues that our students can relate to: anxiety, body image (eating disorders), sleep, selfcare
  - Currently only two school-based therapists on site for student support. GCBH is looking to replace the third, open position.
  - PBIS committee met with Jamie Beirne, CFT rep.
    - We recommended to change the R in SOAR to stand for Resilient, instead of current Respect, that can be tied into Own your Actions.
    - The SOAR Matrix will be revised, presented to ILT for approval and presented to the staff for a vote.

## • Entrance exam – Iowa test update

- Saturday, first retake session for the exam, 250 students who retook the exam; does not include the students who tested in December
- February retest date currently 400 students enrolled
  - Walnut Hills hosting Feb. testing
- December, January, February tests are open to CPS and non-CPS district students
- Students who live in the district of Cincinnati Public Schools are not guaranteed a space
- New business Next LSDMC initiative

- Counselors not responding to emails/requests
- Research Block Scheduling

#### • Principal's report

- Registration, January 23, 7pm; February 19, 7pm; March 19, 7pm
  - In-district students only
- Curriculum
  - ILT approved all incoming students, grades 9-12, will need to take Latin I or Greek I, starting with the 2020-2021 school year.
    - Counts as a Classics Elective course
    - High school Latin
  - ILT approved the requirement of Jr. High Health Course in 7th or 8th grade
    - Target more of the communication skills, middle school skills, stressors, and pressure
- Lawsuit OCR Complaint in Michigan stated that websites need to be ADA compliant. The federal government issued a list of required changes and needed to be made by January 15, 2020.
  - Walnut website is private and although our website may look the same at first glance, colors were changed to support those that are color blind, "click here" changed to "read more", no more scroll on home page, and some other small changes.
- Superintendent proposal redrawing of school boundaries.
  - Superintendent and team are redrawing district for elementary school boundaries.
