4. Principal's report

- a. Enrollment: 2739, down 90 students from last year
 - IOWA test has given us some insight.
 - 1. Students need to learn how to study.
 - 2. SSC is working on teaching kids study skills, organization, time management, etc.
- b. Increased participation in AP program, generally 2600 exams (5 year avg) roughly 1200 kids taking one AP exam. The total number of students: 985 (2018), 1127 (2019), 1178 (2020). Our initiative to open the opportunity to more students is working. 83% of students who took an AP exam scored a 3 or better.
- c. November open entrance exam session 136 students, 60 students passed (140 composite with 65 minimum)

- Average score of 64 in math and 75 in reading
- This group was not a CPS administered test, but for any student (open enrollment and non-cps in district students)
- d. Construction will begin soon. Entrance to Lot D will be changed starting next Friday.
 - We will lose two rows of spaces to allow for the new driveway to the side of the tennis courts brick wall.
 - We will gain two additional spaces (grassy areas by gravel lot in lower Lot D) will be graveled for parking
